### (cont'd) Matthew 17:14-21

"Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me." And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour."

### (cont'd) Matthew 17:14-21

"Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" So Jesus said to them, "Because of your <u>unbelief</u>; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a <u>mustard seed</u>, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."



### Luke 17:5-6

"And the apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." So the Lord said, "If you have faith a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you."





# Fun Fact

A mustard seed measures 1 – 2 millimeters in diameter. Mustard bushes can grow anywhere from 6 to 20 feet high. Potato and vegetable farmers grow mustard bushes to suppress weeds and diseases. Mustard bushes grow so vigorously that any weeds around are smothered into submission.
